Popcorn Balls



Makes: 1-1/2 dozen or 18 servings,
 1 popcorn ball each

12 cups popped popcorn
 1 cup light corn syrup
 1/2 cup sugar
 1 pkg. (4-serving size) JELL-O
 Brand Gelatin, any flavor

1-1/2 cups PLANTERS
 COCKTAIL Peanuts, coarsely
 chopped
 PLACE popcorn in large bowl.
 MIX syrup and sugar in saucepan;
 bring to boil. Remove from heat.
 Add gelatin; stir until dissolved.
 Add peanuts. POUR over popcorn;
 mix well. Cool about 5 minutes.
 Shape into 18 balls, each about 3
 inches in diameter.

 mixture into balls.
